QUALITY INN/SUPER 8 MOTEL CLOSE DUE TO
THE GOVERNOR'S CORONAVIRUS EXECUTIVE ORDER**

The West Branch Visitors Bureau has heeded the Governor's executive order - Stay Home, Stay Safe - directing all Michigan businesses and operations to temporarily suspend in-person operations that are not necessary to sustain or protect life. The order also directs Michiganders to stay in their homes unless they're a part of that critical infrastructure workforce, engaged in an outdoor activity, or performing tasks necessary to the health and safety of themselves or their family, like going to the hospital or grocery store.

The Quality Inn Forward Conference Center and the Super 8 Motel in West Branch are abiding by the Governor's request and suspending operations for the next three weeks.
